

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of FY 2002 Division of Community Health Services/Tuberculosis Control**  
**Services Program Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-342**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Tuberculosis Control Services Program**  
2 **to help prevent the spread of the disease through community education, prevention,**  
3 **early detection, comprehensive regimens and careful follow up with individuals; and**

4 **WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Services**  
5 **Program has been provided in part through supplemental funding sources; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Division of Community Health Services - Tuberculosis Control Services desires to**  
7 **continue the services it provides to TB susceptible patients; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Services Program has received funding**  
9 **from the State of Arizona, Department of Health Services for its program.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 11 **1. That it hereby approves the proposal for funding of the Tohono O'odham**  
12 **Tuberculosis Control Services Program from the State of Arizona Department of**  
13 **Health Services and approves expenditures in accordance with the attached**  
14 **budget.**
- 15 **2. That the duration of this contract shall be from July 01, 2001 and remain in effect**  
16 **as long as the Arizona Department of Health Services agrees to fund the Tohono**  
17 **O'odham Tuberculosis Control Services Program.**
- 18 **3. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman**  
19 **and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this**  
20 **contract.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 25<sup>TH</sup>, Day**  
22 **of JUNE, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,323.35 FOR; 94.15**  
23 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [0] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**  
24 **1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
25 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
26 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
27 **Stat. 984).**

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


