9	nutritional and social support services to eligible elderly members.
10	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:
11	1. That it hereby approves the proposal for Title III funding for the Elderly Program
12	to continue to provide such services it has proposed per attachments in light o
13	the requirements and regulations:

15	2. Title C-1 in the amount of \$66,175
16	3. Title C-2 in the amount of \$6,843
17	4. Cash in Lieu of Commodities (CILC) in the amount of \$5,378
18	2. That the Nation has been informed by Inter-Tribal Council on Aging that the
19	budget period for FY 2002 will be from July 01, 2001 through June 30, 2002.
20	3. That the Tohono O'odham Nation officials, to wit: The Chairman is hereby
21	authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any
22	amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this contract shall be
23	submitted for further prior approval by this Council.
