

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Re-appointment of Albert Manuel, Jr. to the Arizona Advisory Council on Indian Health Care)

RESOLUTION NO. 01-359

1 **WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has created an Advisory Council on Indian Health Care (“Advisory**
2 **Council”) to address the health care needs of American Indian within Arizona**
3 **pursuant to A.R.S. §36-2902.01 (Supp. 2001); and**

4 **WHEREAS, each Arizona Indian tribe may nominate a member for appointment to the Advisory**
5 **Council and submit the nomination to the Governor of the State of Arizona; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council Health and Human Services Committee (“HHS Committee”) has**
7 **been delegated authority “[t]o consult with Federal, State, Counties, and Indian**
8 **agencies, boards, committees, groups, or individuals on programs and activities**
9 **relating to health care, human and welfare services within the Nation” (HHS**
10 **Committee Plan of Operations, adopted by Resolution No. 93-140); and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O’odham Nation has previously nominated the HHS Committee Chairman**
12 **for appointment to the Advisory Council; and**

13 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2000-006, the Tohono O’odham Nation nominated and supported the**
14 **appointment of HHS Committee Chairman Albert Manuel, Jr. to the Advisory Council;**
15 **and**

16 **WHEREAS, Councilman Albert Manuel, Jr. was subsequently appointed to complete the two-year**
17 **Advisory Council term ending on January 15, 2001; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee recommends that its chairman, Albert**
19 **Manuel, Jr., be re-appointed to the Advisory Council and requests that the Tohono**
20 **O’odham Legislative Council support this nomination.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council does hereby**
22 **support and recommend to the Governor of Arizona that Health and Human Services**
23 **Committee Chairman Albert Manuel, Jr. be re-appointed to the Advisory Council on**
24 **Indian Health Care for the term ending January 2003.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council on the 09TH Day**
26 **of JULY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,813.1 FOR; 604.4**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [-0-] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Section 1 (b) & (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O’Odham Nation, adopted by**
29 **the Tohono O’Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




