

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting an appropriation by the U.S. Congress to fund Architectural and
Engineering Plans for a New Adult and Juvenile Correctional Facility)

RESOLUTION NO. 01-360

1 **WHEREAS, the current correctional facility of the Nation is designed for 34 adult inmates yet**
2 **holds an average of over 100 inmates; and**

3 **WHEREAS, overcrowding in the correctional facility presents serious health and safety risks to**
4 **both the inmates and correction staff; and**

5 **WHEREAS, a Corrections Facility Committee, made up of representatives from the Tohono**
6 **O'odham Judicial Branch, the Tohono O'odham Police Department and the**
7 **Department of Planning and Economic Development, was charged with conducting**
8 **an assessment of the current correctional facility and needs; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Corrections Facility Committee assessment identified the need for a facility**
10 **requiring 35-acres, with a 225-bed adult wing and 72-bed juvenile wing, which will**
11 **accommodate expected increases in the inmate population; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Gu-Achi District, located within the boundaries of the Tohono O'odham Nation, has**
13 **allocated a total of 35 acres for the correctional facility; and**

14 **WHEREAS, to meet the identified need for a new, joint adult and juvenile correctional facility,**
15 **architectural design and engineering requirements need to be rendered; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Corrections Facility Committee has estimated that architectural design and**
17 **engineering requirements will cost up to \$1.5 million, construction costs of \$42**
18 **million and annual operations \$7.5 million based upon estimated costs for the Year**
19 **2000.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
21 **authorizes the Chairman of the Nation, together with the Appropriations Committee,**
22 **to seek an appropriation from the U.S. Congress in the amount of \$1.5 million to fund**
23 **the estimated architectural design and engineering requirements of a new, joint adult**
24 **and juvenile correctional facility, while also seeking an appropriation to cover**
25 **construction and first-year operation costs estimated at \$49.5 million based upon**
26 **costs for the estimate Year 2000.**


