9	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Education Department has submitted an appropriation
10	request to expand services provided under the existing programs of the Employment
11	Assistance Program in the amount of \$350,810.33.
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it recognizes
13	and supports the request for budget appropriations in the amount of \$350,810.33.
