

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Support of Tohono O'odham Nation Veterans)

RESOLUTION NO. 01-362

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham men and women have served in all branches of the Armed Force**
2 **in peace time and in combat dating back to World War I to the Persian Gulf; and**

3 **WHEREAS, American Indians have served in the Armed Force of the United States at higher per**
4 **capita rate than any other ethnic minority; and**

5 **WHEREAS, former Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation, the late Josiah Moore, granted the**
6 **Veterans an area to build a Veterans Memorial Park; and**

7 **WHEREAS, there is a need for a Veterans Memorial Monument to honor all who made the**
8 **Supreme sacrifice; and**

9 **WHEREAS, there is a need for a new Veterans Memorial Park where the Veterans Memorial**
10 **Monument can be placed; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the United States Air Force has provided several military replicas for the Tohono**
12 **O'odham Veterans Memorial Park, F-15 jet plane, M-60 tank, 105 howitzer and a**
13 **military personnel carrier; and**

14 **WHEREAS, there is a lack of funds to build the Veterans Memorial Monument and Park.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
16 **calls upon Congress and Administration to set funding for the Veterans Memorial**
17 **Monument and Park in the amount of \$100,000.00.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Appropriations Committee is hereby authorized and directed**
19 **to bring this request to the appropriate agencies, members, and committee of**
20 **Congress.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH Day**
22 **of JULY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
23 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (j) of**
24 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
25 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
26 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**






