RESOLUTION NO. 01-363

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is charged with the responsibility of**
2 **supporting programs and or departments and entities that benefit all Tohono**
3 **O'odham; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education historically has been lacking support staff (i.e. a secretary or**
5 **office worker); and**

6 **WHEREAS, a total of 85 students are currently receiving services under the program, justifying**
7 **the need of support staff; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the hiring of support staff will allow the program to focus more on recruitment and**
9 **retention and completion of Vocational and Academic programs for their students;**
10 **and**


11 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education is anticipating running out of funds before this current fiscal**
12 **year FY-2003 ends.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council fully supports**
14 **the Tohono O'odham Higher Education Services at \$541,343.94.**

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Appropriations Committee is hereby authorized and directed**
16 **to bring this request to the appropriate agencies, members, and committee of**
17 **Congress.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH Day**
19 **of JULY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
20 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (j) of**
21 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
22 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
23 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


