WHEREAS, the Indian Health Care Improvement Act, P.L. 94-437 was first enacted in 1976 to						
address Indian Health Disparities, to increase the number of Health Care						
Professionals Serving Indian Communities, to authorize services to Urban Indian						
Populations, to rectify Indian Health Care facility problems and to provide access to						
Indian Patients to other health care resources such as Medicare/Medicaid; and						
WHEREAS, the Indian Health Care Improvement Act provides comprehensive directives to the						
Federal Government with regard to Indian Health; and, along with the Snyder Act of						
1921, provides overall guidance and authority for the programs of the U.S. Indian						
Health Services; and						
WHEREAS, the Indian Health Care Improvement Act expired at the end of fiscal year 2000; and						
WHEREAS, National Indian Organizations and Tribes participated and consulted with the Indian						
Health Service and Federal Government to advise on the Re-Authorization and						
proposed language changes to the Indian Health Care Improvement Act; and						
WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has participated at the tribal, state, regional and federal						
level in support of the Re-Authorization.						
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports						
the Re-Authorization of the Indian Health Care Improvement Act, P.L. 94-437.						
${f E}$ IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Appropriations Committee is hereby authorized and directed						
to bring this request to the appropriate agencies, members, and committee of						
Congress.						
The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the <u>09<sup>TH</sup>.</u> Day of <u>IULY, 2001</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>2,417.5</u> FOR; <u>-0</u> - AGAINST; <u>-0</u> - NOT VOTING; and <u>[0]</u> ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 ( <u>c)(2)</u> of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
