

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Shift \$35,243.00 from Account 50-1097 to 01-1097 for use in various line items for
operating expenses of the Solid Waste Management Program in FY 2000-2001)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-372

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation"), in exercise of its sovereign authority, desires**
2 **to manage and regulate the storage, collection, recycling, transportation and**
3 **disposal of solid waste and certain hazardous waste on lands within the boundaries**
4 **of the Nation in order to protect the environment, the natural resources, the political**
5 **integrity and economic security of the Nation, and the health, safety and welfare of**
6 **its members and persons present on the Nation's lands; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council ("Legislative Council") adopted the Solid**
8 **Waste Management Code and Solid Waste Management Plan ("Plan") on February 12,**
9 **1997, which in part, established the Solid Waste Management Program, ("SWMP");**
10 **and**

11 **WHEREAS, SWMP has implemented the section of the Plan by creating weekly solid waste**
12 **collection from 700 bins serving over 100 villages, businesses and agencies and**
13 **hauling, on an average, 420 tons of solid waste per month to EPA permitted landfills**
14 **located off of the Nation's lands; and**

15 **WHEREAS, SWMP has collected fees for services and recycling revenue from the sale of**
16 **recyclables and these funds have been deposited in a dedicated account**
17 **#000252452099 with the Bank of America as directed in Resolution #98-236, and said**
18 **resolution states that the funds are to be used for program expenditures; and**

19 **WHEREAS, SWMP is finding that with both its assigned work and additional requests for**
20 **expanded services, that SWMP cannot complete everything it is asked to do with its**
21 **operating budget.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
23 **the use of \$35,243.00 of program revenues that are in account 50-1097 for operating**
24 **expenses in account 01-1097.**

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
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1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day

5 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
6 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
7 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


