RESOLUTION NO. 01-392

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council establishes priorities annually for
2 consideration by Congress during its Appropriations hearings; and

3 WHEREAS, the Legislative Appropriations Committee recommends the establishment of top
4 priorities based on the needs and type of services provided to the people; and


5 WHEREAS, Legislative Appropriations Committee has established four areas as the top priorities
6 for consideration by Congress during the FY 2003 appropriations process.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that
8 it hereby adopts the following appropriations priority ranking for FY 2003 and
9 respectfully urges the United States Congress to appropriate such funds as necessary
10 to increase the four areas to an exemplary level of funding:


13 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day

18 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




