

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending the VISA Amendment Campaign; Transfer of funds from VISA/PASSPORT Project)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-395

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did provide a special appropriation to fund**
2 **activities related to assisting enrolled members residing in Mexico to obtain visas and**
3 **passports as well as to lobby the United States Congress to amend existing visa laws;**
4 **and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch in pursuing these objectives have published a book and**
6 **produced a video to assist in informing the Congress of the issue; and**

7 **WHEREAS, production costs have exceeded the initial estimates and additional funds are**
8 **required; and**


9 **WHEREAS, the VISA/PASSPORT Project has sufficient savings to provide for additional cost.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby**
11 **approve the attached budget amendments as presented by the General Support**
12 **Services, in that:**

- 13 **1. The budget for the VISA/PASSPORT Project is decreased in the amount of \$7,110.00,**
14 **and that the sum is authorized to be transferred to VISA Amendment Campaign.**
15 **2. The budget of the VISA Amendment Campaign is amended in the total amount of**
16 **\$7,110.00.**

17 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day**
18 **of JULY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
19 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)**
20 **& (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
21 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
22 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
23 **Stat. 984).**




