

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(In Support of Higher Education Services FY - 2001, Budget Mod. #2 Acct. #10-1215)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-396

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation through the Higher Education Services program has been**
2 **successfully providing counseling and financial assistance to eligible Tohono**
3 **O'odham to attend Post-Secondary Institutes; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services has a final allocation reduction for FY-2001, due to the**
5 **BIA reduction resulting in the amount of \$1,554.16; and**

6 **WHEREAS, as a result of an in-house budget modification, involving moving funds within the**
7 **budget, the line item (856) for client support to be increased by \$4,000.00.**

8 **WHEREAS, the FY-2001 Budget includes savings from 1997, 1998, 1999 in the amount of**
9 **\$1,078,222.18.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the**
11 **Higher Education Services budget modification #2 reflecting the FY-2001 final**
12 **allocation in the amount of \$704,883.00, also reflecting increase in the line item 856**
13 **by \$4,000.00 and authorizes expenditures per attached budget modification.**

14 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day**
15 **of JULY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
16 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
17 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
18 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
19 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


