

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Legislative Redistricting Proposal of the Tohono O'odham Nation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-401

1 **WHEREAS, the Redistricting Commission developed proposed districts which divides the Tohono**
2 **O'odham Nation and segmented them into five different legislative districts; and**
3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is a federally recognized Indian sovereign government;**
4 **and**
5 **WHEREAS, nine of the Tohono O'odham Nation's eleven political districts are geographically**
6 **compact and contiguous to one another; and**
7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's exterior boundary and the political district boundaries**
8 **have visible geographic features and lines; and**
9 **WHEREAS, it would be more practical and feasible to maintain the contiguous areas of the**
10 **Nation as one district; and**
11 **WHEREAS, the Pasque Yaqui Tribe and other areas identified in our map are also communities**
12 **that have similar and common interest.**
13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
14 **request to the Redistricting Commission to adopt our proposal as presented.**
15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation submit the**
16 **Redistricting proposal and other necessary justification information.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day**
19 **of JULY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,705.05 FOR; 188.3**
20 **AGAINST; 276.05 NOT VOTING; and 248.1 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
21 **by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
22 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
23 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
24 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
