RESOLUTION NO. 01-402

1	WHEREAS,	under the Arizona Independent Redistricting Commission proposal for U.S.
2		Congressional District boundaries, a portion of the main body of the lands of the
3		Tohono O'odham Nation, including the community of Kaka, located in Maricopa
4		County, was excluded; and
5	WHEREAS,	former Congressional District 11 was split into three districts and the newly proposed
6		District 1 now includes Kaka, while the main body of the Nation's lands falls into
7		District 2; and
8	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation is a federally recognized sovereign tribe; and
9	WHEREAS,	under the redistricting principles followed by the Commission, great weight is given
10		to "contiguity, and respect for existing boundaries"; and
11	WHEREAS,	the Commission's proposal ignores the contiguous and existing boundaries of the
12		main body of the Tohono O'odham Nation's lands; and
13	WHEREAS,	to exclude Kaka would dilute the voting rights of Tohono O'odham as a minority
14		group in contravention of the intent of Section 2 of the Voting Rights Act.
15	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby
16		request that the Arizona Independent Redistricting Commission include the
17		community of Kaka in District 2 in conformity to the contiguous boundaries of the
18		main body of the Nation's lands.
19	The foregoi	ng Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11^{TH} . Day
20		01 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of $1.865.75$ FOR; 188.3
		<u>5.35</u> NOT VOTING; and <u>248.1 [04]</u> ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
