

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2001 Bureau of Indian Affairs Budget Range Conservation & Management Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-427

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has historically contracted certain functions from the
2 Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

3 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has approved Resolution No. 2000-284 granting the Executive
4 authorization to submit the Annual Funding Agreement and contract amendment to
5 the Indian Self Determination Act Master contract, and conduct negotiations; and

6 WHEREAS, the Executive Branch requires authority to expend for the Range Conservation &
7 Management program @ \$181,380.82.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Executive Branch is authorized to expend funds for
9 the program listed herein above in the amounts indicated.

10 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH. Day
11 of AUGUST, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-
12 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
13 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
14 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
15 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
16 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
