

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(In Support of Employment Assistance Program, FY 2001 Budget Modification
#II Acct. 10-1206)

RESOLUTION NO. 01-429

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, through the Employment Assistance Program has**
2 **successfully provided vocational counseling and financial assistance to eligible**
3 **Tohono O'odham through Adult Vocational Education and Direct Employment; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Employment Assistance Program has been a benefit to the Nation and its' member**
5 **for numerous years; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Employment Assistance Program has savings from Fiscal Year 2000 in the amount**
7 **of \$6,305.00, which was identified by the Grants & Contracts Office; and**

8 **WHEREAS, as a result of the Tohono O'odham Community College funding percentage from the**
9 **Employment Assistance Program was revised with an increase of \$3,606.00 back to the**
10 **Employment Assistance Program.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports**
12 **the Employment Assistance Program budget modification #II reflecting savings from**
13 **FY-2000 in the amount of \$6,305.00 and \$3,606.00 from the revised funding percentage**
14 **between the Employment Assistance Program and Tohono O'odham Community**
15 **College with a total budget modification #II in the amount of \$346,887.68.**

16 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH. Day**
17 **of AUGUST, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**
18 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
19 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
20 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
21 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
22 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




