

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Adoption of the Domestic Affairs Committee Plan of Operation)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 01-431

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to establish rules**
2 **and procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing**
3 **committees, boards and special committees pursuant to the Constitution of the**
4 **Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1 (a); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is further empowered to prescribe the duties**
6 **and powers of all Legislative Committees (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1 (b)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Rules Committee has reviewed and discussed the purposes, powers and duties of**
8 **the Domestic Affairs Committee; and**


9 **WHEREAS, the Rules Committee recommends the adoption of the Domestic Affairs Plan of**
10 **Operation; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed the attached Plan of Operation**
12 **and has incorporated the necessary changes.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
14 **adopts the attached Plan of Operation for the Domestic Affairs Committee under the**
15 **Legislative Branch.**

16 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH Day of**
17 **AUGUST, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
18 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) and**
19 **(b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
20 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
21 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
22 **Stat. 984).**
