## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Approving the Submission of a Request for a Special Appropriation for Housing by and for San Lucy District of the Tohono O'odham Nation)

1	WHEREAS,	San Lucy District is a political subdivision of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and
2	WHEREAS,	San Lucy District is not geographically located within the boundaries of the main
3		To homoO'odhamIndianReservation, rather, itisontheGilaBendIndianReservation,
4		which is located approximately 120 miles from the Nation's capital of Sells, Arizona;

6	WHEREAS,	by Executive Order dated December 12, 1882, President Chester A. Arthur created the
7		22,400 acre Gila Bend Indian Reservation which was decreased to approximately
8		$10,\!297acresbyExecutiveOrderdatedJune17,\\1909, ofPresidentWilliamHowardTaft;$

10	WHEREAS,	beginning in the late 1970's and as a result of actions of the U.S. Army Corps of
11		Engineers in designing and constructing the Painted Rock Dam on the Gila River,
12		approximately 9,880 acres of reservation lands, which previously comprised the Gila
13		Bend Indian Reservation lands, sustained continual flooding, rendering these lands
14		unsuitable for habitation and economic development; and
15	WHEREAS,	in 1986, the United States Congress enacted Public Law 99-503 (Gila Bend Indian
16		Reservation Lands Replacement Act) as special legislation to provide funds for the
17		replacement  of  damaged  Reservation  land  with  land  suitable  for  sustained  economic
18		and community development, therein recognizing the unique position of San Lucy
19		Districtas9,880acresof ancestralReservationLandswerelostwhenthePaintedRock
20		Dam was constructed; and
21	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has purchased replacement lands for San Lucy District
22		as authorized under Public Law 99-503; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Nation recognizes that San Lucy District is in immediate need of housing for its
24		members and is in immediate need of funding by which to plan and construct such
25		housing to fulfill the needs of San Lucy District members; and
26	WHEREAS,	by  Resolution  No.  SL 03-31-01, the  San Lucy District Council  requested and authorized
27		the drafting and submission of Special Legislation to the U.S. Congress to provide
