

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the submission of six (6) journal manuscripts submitted by the
Pathways Study)

RESOLUTION NO. 01-440

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is the governing body of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

2 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has always viewed the healthcare and well-being of the**
3 **children of the Nation as a priority of the Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council passed Resolution No. 96-026: "Approving Nation's**
5 **participation in a Five-Year Pathways Full Scale project to prevent Early onset of**
6 **Diabetes in school children funded by the national Heart/Lung and Blood Institute";**
7 **and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, in partnership with the Gila River Indian Community**
9 **and the University of Arizona, has been an active participant in the "Obesity**
10 **Prevention in American Children" project; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, when asked permission to do so by all interested parties,**
12 **will share Pathway Project results with other Indian communities and other**
13 **university researchers, of which the Nation's data will remain sole proprietorship of**
14 **the Nation; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the manuscripts titled:**

- 16 **1. *Body composition and prevalence in American Indian schoolchildren enrolled in***
17 ***the Pathways study;***
- 18 **2. *Impact of the Pathways intervention on dietary intakes of American Indian school***
19 ***children;***
- 20 **3. *Obesity in American Indian Children: Prevalence, Consequences, and Prevention;***
- 21 **4. *Validity of self-reported dietary intake by American Indian children: The Pathway***
22 ***Study;***
- 23 **5. *Pathways Process Evaluation Results: A School-Based Prevention Trial to Promote***
24 ***Healthful Diet and Physical Activity in American Indian Third, Fourth and Fifth***
25 ***Grade Students;***
- 26 **6. *How closely do school menus and recipes reflect nutritional intakes of children at***
27 ***school lunch? Results from the Pathways Study;***

1 were presented by the Pathways Project, and have been reviewed by the Tohono
2 O'odham Department of Human Services Research Committee on May 21, 2001;
3 and

4 **WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of Research Committee, Executive Office and the Legislative**
5 **Oversight committee that the manuscripts provide much information and data from**
6 **the study and a very positive report in their data and findings.**

7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and**
8 **endorses the submittal of these six (6) manuscripts to scientific journals for**
9 **consideration of publication.**

10 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the data collected shall remain sole proprietorship of the Tohono**
11 **O'odham Nation.**

12 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH Day**
13 **of AUGUST, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**
14 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
15 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
16 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
17 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
18 **Stat. 984).**




