4	WHEREAS, it is important to establish the FY 2002 revenue projections in a timely manner so that
5	the Nation may use this information to plan its FY 2002 operations; and
6	WHEREAS, pursuant to the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article
7	I, Section 1.G., the Legislative Council has been called into Emergency Session in order
8	to address the Nation's FY 2002 revenue projections; and
0	to address the Nation's F1 2002 revenue projections; and
9	WHEREAS, in order to take action on this issue prior to the September General Session, it is
10	necessary to rescind Legislative Order No. 01-420.
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
12	rescinds Legislative Order No. 01-420, "Tabling the FY 2002 Projected Revenues until
13	the September General Session."

15	AUGUST, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of $1,641.35$ FOR; 776.15

17	Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
18	Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
19	Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
20	18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
