

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2002 Continuing Authorization for the Period of October 01, 2001
through December 31, 2001)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-454

1 **WHEREAS, the current fiscal year expires on September 30, 2001 upon which the authority of the**
2 **Tohono O'odham Nation Government to expend appropriated funds shall also cease;**
3 **and**

4 **WHEREAS, the leadership of the Nation continue to examine the fiscal requirements of all**
5 **governmental operations and capital projects; and**

6 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Nation to enact the necessary authority to permit the**
7 **Nations' government (Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branch) funds to continue**
8 **governmental operations and approved projects beyond September 30, 2001.**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
10 **authorizes the Tohono O'odham Nation's Government to expend funds to continue all**
11 **governmental operations and approved projects beyond September 30, 2001.**

12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the authority granted shall not exceed the authorization levels as**
13 **presented in the attached schedules, or one quarter of final balances as of September**
14 **30, 2001.**

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all employee compensation shall remain at current levels until**
16 **such time that the Nation's fiscal year 2002 budget is formally adopted which may**
17 **authorize, retroactive to October 01, 2001, any necessary employee compensation**
18 **adjustments.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this continuing authorization re-affirms the authority of the**
20 **Nations Government (Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branch) to expend funds**
21 **appropriated for capital projects and other project length appropriations as**
22 **identified in the attached schedules.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day**
25 **of SEPTEMBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,073.95 FOR;**
26 **343.55 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
27 **by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
28 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
30 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


