RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Approving Transfer of Certain Short-Term Investment Accounts)

| 1 | WHEREAS, | pursuant to Resolution No. 91-042 adopted by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council |
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| 2 | | (the "Legislative Council"), as amended by Resolution No. 01-213 (copies of which are |
| 3 | | attached hereto), the Legislative Council approved the Financial Investment Policy |
| 4 | | (the ``Investment Policy") of the Tohono O'odham Nation (the ``Nation") and established |
| 5 | | an Investment Committee consisting of the five members of the Budget and Finance |
| 6 | | Committee of the Legislative Council and two members appointed by the Chairman |
| 7 | | of the Nation; and |
| 8 | WHEREAS, | pursuant to the Investment Policy at paragraph two under INVESTMENT |
| 9 | | MANAGEMENT, the "Investment Committee is authorized to make investment and |
| 10 | | reinvestment decisions for both short-term and long-term accounts"; and |
| 11 | WHEREAS, | fundsreceivedbytheNationfromtheBureauofIndianAffairs("BIAAccount")andthe |
| 12 | | Indian Health Services ("IHS Account"), as well as funds associated with the operation |
| 13 | | of the Nation's Waste Management Program ("Waste Management Account"), have |
| 14 | | been deposited with the Commercial Banking Division of Bank of America in Tucson |
| 15 | | ("BOACB") for investment in a money market fund ("BOACB Money Market Fund"); |
| 16 | | and |
| 17 | WHEREAS, | $designated\ of ficials\ of\ the\ Executive\ Branch\ are\ authorized\ to\ use\ the\ Bamtrac\ System$ |
| 18 | | to transfer funds from the BOACB Money Market Fund to the Nation's General Fund |
| 19 | | Checking Account (No. 002-5307-7497); and |
| 20 | WHEREAS, | Banc of America Securities LLC ("BAS") is a subsidiary Bank of America with offices in |
| 21 | | Dallas, Texas; and |
| 22 | WHEREAS, | funds deposited with BAS are invested in the Nations Funds, including the Treasury |
| 23 | | Reserves Fund which invests in treasury bills and notes issued by the United States, as |
| 24 | | well as repurchase agreements collateralized by treasury bills and notes; and |
| 25 | WHEREAS, | the yield on the BAS Treasury Reserves Fund is approximately twice the yield on the |
| 26 | | BOACB Money Market Fund at this time; and |
| 27 | WHEREAS, | to maximize the return on the Nation's funds in the BIA, IHS and Waste Management |
| 28 | | Accounts, the Investment Committee recommends that the Legislative Council |

authorize transfer of the Accounts from BOACB to BAS for investment in the Treasury

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1. The Chairman of the Nation, acting in his capacity as a member of the Investment Committee, or the Chairperson of the Investment Committee is authorized to transfer all funds in the following accounts at BOACB to BAS for deposit in accounts with the same title and new account numbers designated by BAS prior to transfer:

- 2. BAS is authorized to invest all funds in the BIA, IHS and Waste Management Accounts in the Treasury Reserves Fund.
- 3. Subject to approval of the Investment Committee, the Chairman of the Nation, acting in his capacity as a member of the Investment Committee, or the Chairperson of the Investment Committee is authorized to issue facsimile or other written instructions to BAS to transfer some or all of the funds in the Accounts from the Nations Treasury Reserves Fund for investment in other Nations money market funds.
- 4. Statements issued by BAS on the Accounts shall be transmitted to the Treasurer of the Nation, P.O. Box 837, Sells, Arizona 85634.
- 5. The Chairman of the Nation, the Treasurer of the Nation and the Chairperson of the Investment Committee are each authorized to verbally receive from BAS information related to the Accounts.
- BAS may deal with any and all persons directly or indirectly empowered by this Resolution, as though BAS were dealing with the Tohono O'odham Nation directly.
- 7. The Tohono O'odham Nation is a duly organized and existing Indian Nation established under a Constitution approved by the Secretary of the United States Department of the Interior; the Nation's Constitution empowers the Nation to

- transact the business identified in this Resolution; and no limitation on such business transactions exists in the Nation's Constitution or other applicable law.
- 8. The Legislative Secretary or the Acting Legislative Secretary is authorized to issue a Certification for delivery to BAS, in the form attached hereto, which certifies (a) the name and title of each member of the Investment Committee; (b) the specimen signature of each member of the Investment Committee authorized to issue written instructions to BAS under the terms of this Resolution; and (c) the due enactment and current effectiveness of this Resolution and Resolution No. 91-042 (as amended by Resolution No. 01-213).
- 9. The Legislative Secretary or the Acting Legislative Secretary is authorized to issue such further Certifications for delivery to BAS as may be required to reflect any change in (a) the membership of the Investment Committee, (b) the members authorized to take action under this Resolution or (c) the Resolutions related to authority granted under this Resolution.
- 10. In the event of any change in the office or powers of persons hereby empowered, the Legislative Secretary or the Acting Legislative Secretary shall certify such changes to BAS in writing in the manner herein above provided, which notification, when received, shall be adequate both to terminate the powers of the persons theretofore authorized, and to empower the persons thereby substituted.
- 11. BAS may rely upon any Certification given in accordance with this Resolution, as continuing and fully effective unless and until BAS shall receive due written notice of a change in or the rescission of the authority so evidenced and the dispatch or receipt of any other form of notice shall not constitute a waiver of this requirement, nor shall the fact that any person hereby empowered ceases to be a member of the Investment Committee or becomes an official under some other title in any way affect the powers hereby conferred; provided that the failure to supply any specimen signature shall not invalidate any transaction if the transaction is in accordance with authority actually granted.
- 12. This Resolution and Certifications actually furnished to BAS by the Legislative
