2	for numerous years under the Master Contract; and
3	WHEREAS, the Johnson-O'Malley Program supplements the Gila Bend Unified School District #24,
4	Indian Oasis Baboquivari Unified School District #40, as well as the Tohono O'odham
5	Nation's Early Childhood Head Start Program; and
6	WHEREAS, the amount of \$3,459.00, in addition to the base amount of \$149,658.00, has been
7	allocated as an increase to the Johnson-O'Malley Program budget.
8	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
9	Johnson O'Malley Budget Modification #2, reflecting an increase of \$3,459.00.
10	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amounts of \$149,658.00, base allocation, \$194,108.02, savings
11	and \$3,459.00, final allocation, total the amount of \$347,225.02 for direct funding.
12	BEIT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Johnson-O'Malley Program Budget of \$367,045.02 has increased
13	to \$371,105.89, for FY 2001.
14	The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the $11^{ ext{TH.}}$ day
15	of <u>SEPTEMBER, 2001</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>2,417.5</u> FOR; <u>-0-</u>

17	Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
