RESOLUTION NO. 01-467

1 WHEREAS, the Sells District Treasurer presented the Sells District FY 2002 Budget to the Tohono
2 O'odham Legislative Council for review and approval; and

3 WHEREAS, the FY 2002 Budget covers the cost for the District's Administration in the amount of
4 \$911,972.94; and


5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did review and approved the Sells District
6 Administration Budget.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
8 Sells District FY 2002 Budget in the amount of \$911,972.94.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the remainder of the Gaming Distribution will be deposited in an
10 Interest Bearing Account to cover unforeseen District cost subject to the approval of
11 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

13 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH Day
14 of SEPTEMBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,068.5 FOR; -0-
15 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 349.0 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
16 Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by
17 the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
18 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
19 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




