8	WHEREAS,	the General Assistance Program is tasked with building the Nation's environmental			
9		protection capacity and infrastructure; and			
10	WHEREAS,	the USEPA has reserved \$125,650 for the continuation of the General Assistance			
11		Program through July 31, 2001.			
12	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves			
13		the application for \$125,650 from the USEPA to continue the General Assistance			
14		Program.			
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that the Tohono				
16		O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated			
17		official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however,			
18		that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be			
19		submitted for further prior approval.			
20	BE IT FURT	HER RESOLVED that the GAP program is authorized to expend funds from this grant			
21		beginning on October 01, 2001.			
22	BE IT FURT	THER RESOLVED that this Resolution supercedes Resolution No. 01-454 only as it			
23		pertains to the General Assistance Program grant.
