

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of the Application and Acceptance of the Grant Award for the FY 2002**  
**Indian Environmental General Assistance Program (GAP) Grant)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-489

1 **WHEREAS, Article XVIII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation sets out the Council's**  
2 **continuing responsibility to assure for all members safe and healthful surroundings;**  
3 **and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has taken steps to protect its members and its**  
5 **environment by applying for and receiving grant funds from the United States**  
6 **Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) under the Indian Environmental General**  
7 **Assistance Program (GAP) and other programs; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the General Assistance Program is tasked with building the Nation's environmental**  
9 **protection capacity and infrastructure; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the USEPA has reserved \$125,650 for the continuation of the General Assistance**  
11 **Program through July 31, 2001.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**  
13 **the application for \$125,650 from the USEPA to continue the General Assistance**  
14 **Program.**

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that the Tohono**  
16 **O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated**  
17 **official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however,**  
18 **that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be**  
19 **submitted for further prior approval.**

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the GAP program is authorized to expend funds from this grant**  
21 **beginning on October 01, 2001.**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution supercedes Resolution No. 01-454 only as it**  
23 **pertains to the General Assistance Program grant.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that FY 2001 base salary rates will be utilized.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13<sup>TH</sup>, Day**  
27 **of SEPTEMBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,929.15 FOR; 72.25**  
28 **AGAINST; 416.1 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
29 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
30 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
31 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
32 **Stat. 984).**
