

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Memorandum of Agreement with Bureau of Indian Affairs
for Special Law Enforcement Commissions)

RESOLUTION NO. 01-510

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Public Safety has negotiated a**
2 **Memorandum of Agreement with the Bureau of Indian Affairs Office of Law**
3 **Enforcement Services ("BIA") which will allow the BIA to confer Special Law**
4 **Enforcement Commissions on selected Tohono O'odham police officers; and**

5 **WHEREAS, obtaining the BIA commissions will allow the Tohono O'odham police officers to**
6 **become certified by the United States Marshall's Service to enable the police officers**
7 **to enforce federal law on Tohono O'odham Nation lands and on federal lands**
8 **surrounding the Nation; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is preparing to assign five (5) full time equivalent police**
10 **officers to patrol duties on the Barry M. Goldwater Range to prevent destruction of**
11 **cultural sites and natural resources, under a Cooperative Agreement with the United**
12 **States Air Force which includes funding provided by the Air Force; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed this proposal and recommends it for**
14 **approval by the Legislative Council.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
16 **approves the Memorandum of Agreement with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for Special**
17 **Law Enforcement Commissions, in the form attached hereto, subject to editorial**
18 **changes which may be required by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and authorizes the**
19 **Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation to execute the document and any other**
20 **documentation reasonably necessary to implement the intent of this Memorandum**
21 **of Agreement.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day**
23 **of OCTOBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,732.75 FOR; -0-**
24 **AGAINST; 684.75 NOT VOTING; and [-0-] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
25 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
28 **Stat. 984).**
