

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Modification of Budgets for the Office of the Attorney General
and the Office of the Chairman of the Nation)

RESOLUTION NO. 01-514

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopted Resolution No. 99-585 for an
2 intergovernmental and public relations strategy to advance the interests of the
3 Tohono O'odham Nation in Fiscal Year 2000; and

4 WHEREAS, the funds and purposes of Resolution No. 99-585 were continued under Resolution No.
5 2000-467; and

6 WHEREAS, gaming litigation funds were overestimated and yet the critical efforts of public
7 relations and lobbying remain ongoing and need to be continued through Fiscal Year
8 2002; and

9 WHEREAS, the Office of the Chairman has proposed a modification of the budget of the Office of
10 the Attorney General which transfers \$171,250.00 from OAG Gaming Litigation Account
11 01-4236 to the Office of the Chairman Account 01-4235, which was presented to the
12 Commerce and Budget and Finance Committees of the Council.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves
14 the budget modification described in the Program Abstract as attached and
15 incorporated by this reference.

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day
18 of OCTOBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,403.05 FOR; 899.1
19 AGAINST; 115.35 NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
20 Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
21 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
22 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
23 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
