

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Budget Justification for the FY 2002 Bureau of Indian Affairs Fund Account 10-5015,**  
**Water Resources Study Program Continuation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-515

1 WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program of the Natural Resources Department has  
2 accumulated savings in fiscal years 1997 through 2001 in its Bureau of Indian Affairs  
3 funding provided by the Nation's Master Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs,  
4 Contract No. 1450CTH54T61071, in the estimated total amount of \$204,417.13; and

5 WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program has proposed a budget for fiscal year 2002 in the  
6 amount of \$286,032.32 to be supplied by carryover funds plus FY 2002 P.L. 93-638  
7 funds; and


8 WHEREAS, this budget continuation has been reviewed by the Water Resources Committee and  
9 the Budget and Finance Committee and is recommended for approval by the  
10 Legislative Council.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the  
12 carryover of savings of Bureau of Indian Affairs funds provided by the Nation's Master  
13 Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Contract No. 1450CTH54T61071, for the  
14 Water Resources Study Program in the total amount of \$172,032.32.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the total budget continuation funding for fiscal year 2002 of  
16 \$286,032.32 for the Water Resources Study Program is approved in accordance with  
17 the budget attached hereto.

18 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10<sup>TH</sup> Day  
19 of OCTOBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,145.55 FOR; -0-  
20 AGAINST; 271.95 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
21 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
22 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
23 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
24 Stat. 984).
