RESOLUTION NO. 01-516

1 WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program of the Natural Resources Department has
2 accumulated savings in fiscal years 1997 through 2001 in its P.L. 93-638 Bureau of
3 Reclamation Grant in the estimated total amount of \$3,483,770.90; and

4 WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program has proposed a budget for fiscal year 2002 in the
5 amount of \$1,935,281.74; and


6 WHEREAS, this budget continuation has been reviewed by the Water Resources Committee and
7 the Budget and Finance Committee and is recommended for approval by the
8 Legislative Council.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the
10 carryover of savings of Bureau of Reclamation funds provided by the P.L. 93-638
11 Bureau of Reclamation Grant, for the Water Resources Study program in the total
12 amount of \$1,935,281.74.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the total budget continuation funding for fiscal year 2002 of
14 \$1,935,281.74 for the Water Resources Study Program is approved in accordance with
15 the budget attached hereto.

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day
18 of OCTOBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,229.2 FOR; -0-
19 AGAINST; 188.3 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
20 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
21 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
22 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
23 Stat. 984).


