

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Budget Justification for the FY 2002 Environmental Protection Agency 106 Grant,
Water Resources Study Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-517

1 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program of the Natural Resources Department has been**
2 **awarded an Environmental Protection Agency 106 Grant in the total amount of**
3 **\$150,000.00 and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program will provide \$8,047.00 in-kind contribution in the**
5 **form of personnel salaries for geographic information system data base construction**
6 **and global positioning surveys of water wells; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program has proposed a budget for fiscal year 2002 in the**
8 **amount of \$150,000.00; and**

9 **WHEREAS, this budget continuation has been reviewed by the Water Resources Committee and**
10 **the Budget and Finance Committee and is recommended for approval by the**
11 **Legislative Council.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
13 **new program budget for the Environmental Protection Agency 106 Grant, for the**
14 **Water Resources Study Program in the total amount of \$150,000.00.**

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Water Resources Study Program will provide \$8,047.00 in-kind**
16 **contribution in the form of personnel salaries for geographic information system data**
17 **base construction and global positioning surveys of water wells.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the continuation of work under this funding in FY 2003 and**
19 **subsequent years is wholly dependant upon renewal of the Environmental Protection**
20 **Agency Grant and there will be no obligation for funding by the Tohono O'odham**
21 **Nation.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day**
23 **of OCTOBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
25 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
28 **Stat. 984).**
