

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Consolidated Healthy O'odham Promotion Program and Data Improvement**  
**Project FY 2002 Budget (October 1, 2001-September 30,2002))**

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-519**

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation receives a Special Diabetes Programs for Indians grant**  
2 **through FY 2004; and**
- 3 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 99-149, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the**  
4 **establishment of the Community Based Diabetes Prevention Program, funded by the**  
5 **Special Diabetes Programs for Indians, authorized by the Balanced Budget Act of 1997;**  
6 **and**
- 7 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 98-150, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the**  
8 **establishment of the Data Improvement Program under the Special Diabetes**  
9 **Programs for Indians, authorized by the Balanced Budget Act of 1997; and**
- 10 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2000-182, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the**  
11 **name change of the Community Based Diabetes Program to the Healthy O'odham**  
12 **Promotion Program; and**
- 13 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2000-222, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the**  
14 **Healthy O'odham Promotion Program's request to change its fiscal year from June**  
15 **through May to the Nation's standard October through September fiscal calendar; and**
- 16 **WHEREAS, the United States Indian Health Service Grants Management Branch routinely**  
17 **consolidates the Healthy O'odham Promotion Program and Data Improvement**  
18 **Program appropriation into a single grant award to the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**
- 19 **WHEREAS, to improve grant management and accounting of the Special Diabetes Programs for**  
20 **Indians award to the Tohono O'odham Nation, the Tohono O'odham Department of**  
21 **Health and Human Services is requesting to consolidate the Healthy O'odham**  
22 **Promotion Program and Data Improvement Grant Funds (11-1453 and 11-1455,**  
23 **respectively) into a single account for Fiscal Year 2002; and**
- 24 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services is requesting the**  
25 **Fiscal Year 2002 budget to cover anticipated costs for continuing the Healthy O'odham**  
26 **Promotion Program.**

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

1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 2           **1. approves the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services'**  
3           **request to consolidate the Healthy O'odham Promotion Program and Data**  
4           **Improvement Grant funds (11-1453 and 11-1455, respectively) into a single**  
5           **account for Fiscal Year 2002; and**
- 6           **2. approves the Healthy O'odham Promotion Program Fiscal Year 2002 budget; and**  
7           **3. funding in FY 2003 and subsequent years is wholly dependant upon continued**  
8           **grant funding and there will be no obligation for funding by the Tohono O'odham**  
9           **Nation.**

10 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10<sup>TH</sup>. Day**  
11 **of OCTOBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**  
12 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
13 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
14 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
15 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
16 **Stat. 984).**
