5		to negotiate a compact with the State of Arizona for the operation of Class III gaming
6		activities within the Tohono O'odham Nation, subject to final approval by the
7		Legislative Council (Resolution No. 260-89, Resolution No. 91-346 and Resolution No.
8		93-121); and

13		through August 18, 2003; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation, in cooperation with the Arizona Indian Gaming
15		Association, is negotiating with the State of Arizona to ensure the continued operation
16		of its gaming facilities; and
17	WHEREAS,	it is in the Nation's best interest to again delegate compact negotiating authority to a
18		$committee \ of \ elected \ of ficials \ for \ the \ purpose \ of \ reaching \ a \ gaming \ compact \ with \ the$
19		State of Arizona.
20	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby

22		negotiate a gaming compact with the State of Arizona on behalf of the Nation and
23		pursue any other measures by which Class III gaming may be conducted.
