6	WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract expired on September 30, 2001; and
7	WHEREAS, continued representation is necessary to protect the Nation's interests in these
8	proceedings; and
9	WHEREAS, the Operating Budget for the Office of Attorney General for the first quarter of Fisca
10	Year 2002, as approved by the Legislative Council in Resolution No. 01-454, has
11	sufficient funds for an attorney contract in the amount of \$20,000.00 for
12	representation in these proceedings; and
13	WHEREAS, the Attorney General has proposed an attorney contract with California Indian Legal
14	Services, in the amount of \$20,000.00, a copy of which is attached hereto; and
15	WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative Council of
16	an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys on such terms.
17	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
18	1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves an Attorney Contract
19	with California Indian Legal Services in the amount of \$20,000 for the period
20	ending December 31, 2001 and in the form attached hereto.
21	2. Funding for the Attorney Contract shall be provided under the authority of
22	Resolution No. 01-454 in the operating budget for the Office of Attorney General
23	3. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the Attorney
