

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Attorney Contract with Law Firm of Williams, Janov & Cooney)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-533**

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution Nos. 99-596 and 2000-501, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**  
2 **approved an Attorney Contract with the law firm of Williams, Janov & Cooney (the**  
3 **"Attorneys") to provide legal representation with respect to certain of the Nation's**  
4 **water matters; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract expired on September 30, 2001; and**

6 **WHEREAS, continued representation regarding water matters is required to protect the Nation's**  
7 **interests; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Operating Budget for the Office of Attorney General for the first quarter of Fiscal**  
9 **Year 2002, as approved by the Legislative Council in Resolution No. 01-454, has**  
10 **sufficient funds for an attorney contract in the amount of \$5,000.00 for representation**  
11 **in these proceedings; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Attorney General has proposed an attorney contract with the Attorneys, in the**  
13 **amount of \$5,000.00, a copy of which is attached hereto; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative Council of**  
15 **an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys on such terms.**

16 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 17 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves an Attorney Contract**  
18 **with the Attorneys in the amount of \$5,000 for the period ending December 31,**  
19 **2001 and in the form attached hereto.**
- 20 **2. Funding for the Attorney Contract shall be provided under the authority of**  
21 **Resolution No. 01-454 in the operating budget for the Office of Attorney General.**
- 22 **3. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the Attorney**  
23 **Contract.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
25 **of OCTOBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**  
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
27 **Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
28 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
30 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


