11	WHEREAS, the Operating Budget for the Office of Attorney General for the first quarter of Fisca
12	Year 2002, as approved by the Legislative Council in Resolution No. 01-454, has
13	sufficient funds for an attorney contract in the amount of \$5,000.00 for representation
14	in these proceedings; and
15	WHEREAS, the Attorney General has proposed an attorney contract with the Attorneys, in the
16	amount of \$5,000.00, a copy of which is attached hereto; and
17	WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative Council o
18	an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys on such terms.
19	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
20	1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves an Attorney Contrac
21	with the Attorneys in the amount of \$5,000 for the period ending December 31
22	2001 and in the form attached hereto.
23	2. Funding for the Attorney Contract shall be provided under the authority of
24	Resolution No. 01-454 in the operating budget for the Office of Attorney General
25	3. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the Attorney
