4	WHEREAS, the Legislative Council recognizes the need for legislative and administrative
5	advocacy concerning federal programs, services, and other federal activities affecting
6	the Nation; and
7	WHEREAS, the firm of Ducheneaux, Taylor & Associates, Inc. has continued to provide such
8	services in Fiscal Year 2001, including: advising the Nation regarding federal
9	appropriations, legislation, and programs; acting as a liaison with the United States
10	Executive and Legislative Branches; arranging meetings with federal officials;
11	providing regular client memoranda on federal activities affecting the Nation; and
12	WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation has appropriated \$17,500
13	pursuant to Resolution No. 01-454 for purpose of funding these services for the period
14	beginning October 1, 2001 and ending December 31, 2001.
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Chairman
16	of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Chairwoman of the Legislative Council are
17	hereby authorized to execute the attached "Service Agreement" between the Nation
18	and Ducheneaux, Taylor & Associates, Inc.
19	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, pursuant to Resolution No. 01-454, this Service Agreement shall
20	be effective October 1, 2001 and shall terminate December 31, 2001.
21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Service Agreement's total cost, including all fees, costs, and
22	expenses for the period from October 1, 2001 through December 31, 2001 shall not
23	exceed \$17,500.
24	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that any proposed amendments affecting the Service Agreement's
25	funding levels or termination date shall be submitted to the Legislative Council for
26	approval.
