1	WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council held a special meeting on October 24, 2001 to address
2	the FY 2002 budget of the Hickiwan District; and
3	WHEREAS, the District Council is aware that the Tohono O'odham Nation will be in a deficit for

	the next three (3) years beginning with the FY 2002 Budget; and
5	WHEREAS, the District Council is also aware of government branches requesting for a salary wage
6	adjustment for FY 2002; and
7	WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council strongly recommends that a moratorium be placed on
8	all requests for salary wage adjustments pursuant to the Valliant Study, within the
9	Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branches for the next three (3) years or until the
10	Nation is financially sound; and
11	WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to seek a remedy to the deficit
12	and not to add to the growth of the deficit; and
13	WHEREAS, there is still a great need of services to be provided to the Nation's members and
14	should take priority, i.e. housing, elderly care, dialysis, medical care, roads, and
15	education, to name a few; and
16	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's branches and Districts must work together to plan for
17	the future of the Tohono O'odham Nation for the benefit of all members.
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council imposes a
19	moratorium on all salary wage adjustments of the three branches of government
20	pursuant to the Valliant Study (and any other studies conducted) for a term of three
21	years beginning with Fiscal Year 2002.
22	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following imposed moratorium will supercede Resolution Nos.
23	01-454 and 01-107.
24	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the imposed moratorium will not effect the following:
25	COLA increases applied to any salaries and the eleven district budgets.
