

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Recognizing and Supporting The Judiciary Classification/Compensation Plan
Established by the Chief Judge of the Tohono O'odham Judiciary for FY 2002,
effective October 01, 2001)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-613

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Constitution provides that the Chief Judge shall act as**
2 **Administrative Officer of the Courts, Title II, Section 1-105 of the Tohono O'Odham**
3 **Civil Code provides that the Chief Judge shall exercise administrative supervision of**
4 **the Tohono O'odham Courts; and**

5 **WHEREAS, duties and obligations of the Chief Judge in exercising administrative supervision of**
6 **the Courts include the creation of positions and setting of the salaries of Judiciary**
7 **employees. These duties are essential to the existence and proper operation of the**
8 **Courts; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary established its own Position and Salary Compensation Plan by its**
10 **Administrative Order executed by the Chief Judge on the 20th day of August, 1997**
11 **entitled Establishing a Judiciary Classification/Compensation Plan and Aligning**
12 **Judiciary Positions and Salaries in Accordance with the Classification/Compensation**
13 **Plan adopted by Legislative Council Resolution Number 96-425 and Resolution**
14 **Number 97-417, recognizing and supporting the Judiciary Classification/**
15 **Compensation Plan Established by the Chief Judge of the Tohono O'odham Judiciary,**
16 **effective September 29, 1997; and**

17 **WHEREAS, on April 30, 2001, the Legislative Council approved the Executive Branch Wage/Salary**
18 **Compensation Administration for FY 2002, effective October 01, 2001, Resolution No.**
19 **01-179, which was approved in order to maintain a competitive salary and position**
20 **classification for its employees in order to facilitate the highest level of service**
21 **delivery to members of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary Compensation Plan is based on a fair and accurate analysis of salaries**
23 **and positions and incorporates the Nation's Valliant study. The following cost is**
24 **proposed for FY 2002;**

2 **analysis of salaries and positions.**

3 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that the Judiciary Classification/**
4 **Compensation Plan, which has been established and adopted by the Judiciary Branch,**
5 **is hereby recognized and supported.**

6 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that sufficient funds in the amount of \$372,048.00 are appropriated**
7 **and authorized from sources available for the FY 2002 Judiciary Branch Tribal budget**
8 **for support of the FY 2002 Judicial Classification/Compensation Plan.**

9 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH. Day**
10 **of DECEMBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,248.25 FOR; 916.2**
11 **AGAINST; 92.35 NOT VOTING; and 160.7[03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
12 **by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**
13 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
14 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
15 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


