RESOLUTION NO. 01-624

1 **WHEREAS, on December 10, 2001, the Baboquivari District Council did meet and approve the FY**
2 **2002 Baboquivari District Supplement Budgets; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the District Council did approve for gaming revenues in the amount of \$500,000.00 to**
4 **be divided equally among the six (6) communities with 90% to be divided among the**
5 **six (6) communities and 10% distributed to the administration; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the following distribution of gaming revenues is allocated to the six (6) communities**
7 **and administration of the Baboquivari District totaling in the amount of \$500,000.00;**

17 **WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District FY 2002 Supplement Budgets will commence and become**
18 **effective on January 2002 and end on September 30, 2002.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
20 **the Baboquivari District FY 2002 Budget in the amount of \$500,000.00 to be distributed**
21 **with 10% to Baboquivari District Administration in the amount of \$500,000.00 and 90%**
22 **to be divided among the six (6) communities of the Baboquivari District in the amount**
23 **of \$75,000.00 each for a total of \$450,000.00.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH Day**
26 **of DECEMBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,840.7 FOR; 416.1**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 160.7 [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Section 1 (d)(2)&(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
29 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
