

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Executive Assistant's Position Without Reclassification for Inclusion in
Executive Branch FY 2002 Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-625

1 **WHEREAS, on December 20, 2001 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council held a Special Session**
2 **to address the FY 2002 budgets for the Executive and Judicial Branches; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch presented its FY 2002 Executive Office budget with two options**
4 **for one of its Executive Assistant positions; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the first option proposed to reclassify one Executive Assistant's position within the**
6 **Executive Office to the position of Special Counsel to the Chairman; the second option,**
7 **as reflected in a separate personnel chart, retained the Executive Assistant's position**
8 **without reclassification; and**

9 **WHEREAS, during the joint Budget and Finance Committee and the Executive Review**
10 **Committee's meeting to review the FY 2002 Executive Branch budgets, a majority of the**
11 **Budget and Finance Committee did not approve the Executive Assistant position's**
12 **reclassification to Special Counsel to the Chairman; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council, in order to clarify which salary and position would be**
14 **approved upon adoption of the total Executive Branch budget, did vote to incorporate**
15 **the budget containing the salary and position for the Executive Assistant without**
16 **reclassification into the total Executive Branch budget and thereby rejected the**
17 **proposed reclassification.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
19 **the Executive Office of the Chairman of the Nation FY 2002 budget for inclusion in the**
20 **total FY 2002 Executive Branch Budget with the following clarification: the salary and**
21 **position of Executive Assistant shall be funded as reflected in the attached personnel**
22 **chart and without reclassification to "Special Counsel to the Chairman."**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH Day**
25 **of DECEMBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,667.0 FOR; 750.5**
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
28 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
30 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
