

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Request for Budget Carry Over and Capital Project Funding for the
Design, Construction, Staffing and Operations of a Cultural Center/Museum
for the Tohono O'odham Nation)

RESOLUTION NO. 01-626

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of cultural history as part of**
2 **an educational priority; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes that many of the Nation's cultural artifacts**
4 **have been removed from the Nation and are stored in museums in Arizona, out-of-**
5 **state and in foreign countries and that the Nation needs to build a Cultural**
6 **Center/Museum so these cultural artifacts that represent such an important part of**
7 **Tohono O'odham history can be returned to the Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of keeping "himdag" alive now**
9 **and into the future; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation supports the concept of a Cultural Center/Museum for**
11 **the Nation; and**

12 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2000-275, the Tohono O'odham Nation did approve the**
13 **request for appropriation for design, construction, staffing and operations of a**
14 **Culture Center/Museum totaling \$15,191,080.00; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch was delegated formal authority to implement Capital Project**
16 **Funding in accordance with provisions of GAAP (Resolution No. 2000-446); and**

17 **WHEREAS, the approved and authorized budget for the Culture Center/Museum Capital Project**
18 **was \$1,000,000.00 for FY 2001; and**

19 **WHEREAS, expenditures from the FY 2001, Cultural Center/Museum Project totaled \$91,960.05**
20 **resulting in an unexpended balance of \$908,039.95; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the total proposed budget for the Cultural Center/Museum Project for FY 2002 is**
22 **\$990,378.55; and**

23 **WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Department, Cultural Affairs Office, Cultural Center/Museum**
24 **Project respectfully requests the FY 2001 balance of \$908,039.95 be carried over to the**
25 **FY 2002 Budget Period and that Capital Project Funds of \$82,336.60 be appropriated**
26 **to total the Cultural Center/Museum Project, FY 2002 budget request of \$990,378.55.**

1 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
2 **supports and approves** the Natural Resources Department, Cultural Affairs Office,
3 **Cultural Center/Museum Project request to carry over the FY 2001 budget balance of**
4 **\$908,039.95 to the FY 2002 budget period.**

5 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the
6 **appropriation of \$82,336.60 from Capital Project Funding to be added to carry over**
7 **balance from FY 2001 to total the Cultural Center/Museum Project FY 2002 budget**
8 **request of \$990,378.55**

9 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20th Day**
10 **of DECEMBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,528.9 FOR; 888.6**
11 **AGAINST; -0-NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
12 **1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
13 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
14 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
15 **Stat. 984).**
