

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving and Authorizing Fiscal Year 2002 Initiative Reserve Allocation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-628

1 **WHEREAS, Initiative In-01-97 authorized the establishment of reserves to fund the activities**
2 **required under the provisions of the Initiative; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council previously authorized \$1,150,000.00 for the Economic**
4 **Development Grant program and it is necessary to approve and re-authorize an**
5 **additional amount of \$2,350,000.00 for FY 2002; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch has developed a budget to allocate funds for the design and**
7 **construction of Youth Centers within various districts; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch is estimating that the unexpended balance of the O'odham**
9 **Charitable Grant reserve will be approximately \$150,000.00 and the Branch is**
10 **requesting the amount be authorized for FY 2002 under the Office of the Chairman.**


11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
12 **authorizes an additional \$2,350,000.00 from the Economic Development Grant**
13 **Reserve for a total amount of \$3,500,000.00 for FY 2002.**

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$15,493,443.88 is hereby re-authorized from the Youth Center**
15 **Project Reserve for FY 2002.**

16 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the unexpended balance of the O'odham Charitable Grant reserve,**
17 **in the amount of \$150,000.00 is hereby re-authorized for FY 2002 under the Office of**
18 **the Chairman's budget; the Office shall administer the grants.**

19 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH, Day**
20 **of DECEMBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**
21 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 02 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
22 **1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
23 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
24 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
25 **Stat. 984).**


