

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Allocate Additional Revenue for Equipment Purchases and Authorize the funding
of the Existing Solid Waste Educator with Program Revenue)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-631

1 **WHEREAS, SWMP has collected fees for services and recycling revenue from the sale of**
2 **recyclables and these funds have been deposited in a dedicated account #252-452-099**
3 **with the Bank of America, as directed in Resolution No. 98-236, and said resolution**
4 **states that the funds are to be used for program expenditures; and**

5 **WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2000-309 allocates SWMP revenue for the purchase of equipment and**
6 **the funding of certain staff positions; and**


7 **WHEREAS, the Office of the Treasurer has provided a current report of investment summary for**
8 **Waste Management Money Market Account #252-452-099 and it has a balance of**
9 **\$321,815.53.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby amends**
11 **Resolution No. 2000-309 to approve the use of an additional \$285,673.62 of program**
12 **revenues for the purchase of additional solid waste equipment as detailed in Revenue**
13 **Budget 44-1097.**

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is funded up to a full time solid waste educator position**
15 **(\$27,801.47 annual prorated), starting January 01, 2002, which is currently funded by**
16 **EPA Grant #PJ-989113-01-1 through December 31, 2001 and that this position become**
17 **part of the SWMP's future base budget 44-1097 and be funded by program revenues.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH Day**
19 **of DECEMBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,333.85 FOR; -0-**
20 **AGAINST; 83.65 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
21 **Section 1 (d)(2)&(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
22 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
23 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
24 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
