## **RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL** (Appropriating \$2.2 Million from the Mining and Chemical Fund for the Purposes of Government and Public Relations to Support Indian Gaming)

**RESOLUTION NO.** <u>01-633</u>

1	WHEREAS,	the continued operation of the Nation's gaming facilities is essential to the Nation's
2		ability to fund government operations at current levels; and
3	WHEREAS,	the Arizona Indian Gaming Association("AIGA") has initiated a statewide government
4		and public relations campaign designed to support the uninterrupted continuation
5		of Indian gaming operations; and
6	WHEREAS,	AIGA member tribes have agreed to make a contribution to fund the AIGA campaign;
7		and
8	WHEREAS,	the Nation's representatives to AIGA recommend that the Nation support the AIGA
9		campaign and supplement that statewide effort with the Nation's own government and
10		public relations effort to obtain local, State and national support for Indian gaming;
11		and
12	WHEREAS,	support of local, State and Federal political campaigns, political action committees
13		(i.e., National Congress of American Indian and National Indian Gaming Association
14		sponsored political action fund raisers and events) and political parties, together form
15		a key element of the Nation's strategy for government relations; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Chairman of the Nation has submitted a proposed budget for government and
17		public relations in the amount of \$2,200,000.00(a copy of which is attached hereto and
18		incorporated by this reference), which would fund both the AIGA campaign and the
19		Nation's own government and public relations effort; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Nation's Treasurer has identified that sufficient funds are available in the Mining
21		and Chemical Fund, Account No. 1067513(the "Fund"), and that use of the Fund is not
22		restricted; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Commerce Committee, the Budget and Finance Committee, and the Chairman of
24		the Nation recommend that \$ 2,200,000.00 be appropriated from the Fund for the
25		purpose of funding both the AIGA statewide government and public relations
26		campaign, and the Nation's own government and public relations effort.
27	NOW, THEF	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby appropriates \$2,200,000.00
28		from the Mining and Chemical Fund, Account No. 1067513, to the budget of the Office
