(FY 2002 Bureau of Indian Affairs Budgets)**

3 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has approved Resolution No.: 01-351 granting the Executive**
4 **authorization to submit the Annual Funding Agreement (AFA) to the Indian Self**
5 **Determination Act Master Contract; and**
