

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2002 Food Distribution Program - Budget and Proposal)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-636

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Food Distribution Program**
2 **under an FY 2001 Grant with the United States Department of Agriculture; and**

3 **WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'odham**
4 **Nation and the people; and**

5 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to apply for FY 2002 United**
6 **States Department of Agriculture funds to assist eligible families with commodity**
7 **foods; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to secure funding for provision of services**
9 **during fiscal year 2002; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services has submitted for review and**
11 **approval a scope of work and budget that will conform to the eligibility criteria set**
12 **forth in the funding and reporting regulations.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 14 **1. That it does hereby authorize the officials of the Tohono O'odham Nation to**
15 **submit a request for United States Department of Agriculture funding, and**
16 **authorizes expenditures in accordance to the attached budget.**
- 17 **2. That the duration of this grant shall be from October 01, 2001 through September**
18 **30, 2002.**
- 19 **3. That the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in the**
20 **interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no executed grant has**
21 **been approved by the United States Department of Agriculture.**
- 22 **4. That the Tohono O'odham Nation's officials, to wit: The Chairman, Vice-Chairman**
23 **and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the**
24 **grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding**
25 **levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

7 Stat. 984).
