

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Fiscal Year 2002 Head Start Federal Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 01-638

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated a Head Start Program to provide
2 educational, health, mental health, and parent involvement services to children,
3 three to five years of age; and

4 WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and
5 Families provides funds for the continued operation of the Head Start Program; and

6 WHEREAS, the Head Start Program has prepared a funding proposal to be submitted to the U.S.
7 Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families
8 (DHHS/ACF).

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does
10 hereby approves the Tohono O'odham Nation Head Start Fiscal Year 2002 budget in
11 the amount \$55,905.54 for Administration Cost, and \$1,452,677.46 for Program Cost,
12 for a grand total Fiscal Year 2002 Head Start award of \$1,508,583.00 and the Tohono
13 O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the Fiscal Year 2002 Head Start Tribal
14 Match budget in the amount of \$320,474.25.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
16 Nation's officials to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
17 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant provided that any amendments
18 affecting the funding or funding levels of this grant shall be submitted for approval
19 by this Council.

20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20th. Day
21 of DECEMBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-
22 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section
23 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
24 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
25 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
26 Stat. 984).


