

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(In support of the FY 2002 Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation
Program Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 01-644

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has previously supported the Nation's**
2 **Education Department in submitting a grant proposal and establishing a vocational**
3 **rehabilitation program under Resolution No. 98-202; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a grant under the Rehabilitation Services**
5 **Administration's Section 121 (Vocational Rehabilitation Services Projects for**
6 **American Indians with Disabilities) of the Rehabilitation Act and received grant**
7 **notification number H250G980011; and**

8 **WHEREAS, services under the Tohono O'odham Nation's Vocational Rehabilitation Program, who**
9 **reside on the Tohono O'odham Nation, will be provided to eligible American Indians**
10 **with disabilities, with enrolled Tohono O'odham members being first priority; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the services provided will be consistent with individual strengths, resources,**
12 **priorities, concerns, abilities, capabilities and informed choice of eligible American**
13 **Indians so that they may prepare for and engage in gainful employment.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the**
15 **FY 2002 Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program budget in the**
16 **amount of \$433,997.00 with \$35,538.00 designated as the In Kind/Match Funds from**
17 **the Nation.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
19 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any designated official are hereby**
20 **authorized to execute and expend the grant award and provide continued culturally**
21 **appropriate vocational rehabilitation services to its eligible consumers, provided**
22 **however that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this grant**
23 **shall be submitted for further approval.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20th, Day**
25 **of DECEMBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
27 **1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
28 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
30 **Stat. 984).**
