5	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with				
6	Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to fund and operate the Women, Infants and Children				
7	(WIC) Program which commenced on October 01, 2001 through September 30, 2006;

9	WHEREAS, the services provided to eligible clients have been beneficial and services continue to				
10	be necessary to help alleviate nutritional health risks and improve the health of				
11	individuals at risk.				
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:				
13	1. The Tohono O'odham Nation approves the proposal for funding from the Inter-				
14	Tribal Council of Arizona to continue to operate and provide services to eligible				
15	women, infants and children.				
16	2. The Memorandum of Agreement shall continue through September 30, 2002.				
17	3. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman				
18	and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this				
19	contract associated with this program and to expend funds when received.
